

inmates complied, but made comments about Mayor Bowers new indoor mask policy taking effect in November. At this point, Officer J. Johnson made comments about "White Privilege", and the situation was escalated significantly by her comments. I find her comments to be in direct violation of the jail policy, specifically on Page 1, number 8 of the inmate handbook which reads: "Freedom from discrimination based on RACE, COLOR, religion, national origin, sex, age, marital status, PERSONAL APPEARANCE, sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, familial status, family responsibilities, matriculation, political affiliation..." This is twice within 60 days that I have personally witnessed and been a part of an officers racial discriminatory behavior towards me, and other inmates around me. The first incident that happened on September 18th is STILL under investigation, and has not been resolved. There were multiple witnesses to this event: -Jon Mellis -Billy Chrestman - Doug Jensen -Peter Schwartz -Brandon Fellows -Sean McHugh Along with others that I do not remember. I look forward to hearing your response, and will need a copy of this for my attorney, Joseph McBride. Thank you
