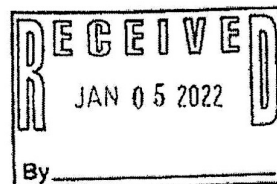

The week of December 19th-25th, DC DOC knew there was a massive covid outbreak within the jail. Since receiving the medical stay in place memo, I have been locked down to 22 hours or more per day in our cells within solitary confinement, but have not been tested for covid. A covid positive officer, officer cabbagestalk, came on our unit, and shortly after was sent home on covid leave. We know this to be true, because this was confirmed by multiple officers working on the unit, and heard by multiple inmates. This is one example of probably MULTIPLE officers that this type of positive contact happened with. Though the jail knew that the officer was covid positive and had walked into our unit, they did not inform anyone within the unit that we had come into contact with a covid positive person, nor did they take any extra measure to ensure inmates did not contract the virus. Subsequently, and as you could expect, many inmates within C2B have become sick, and I believe it to be the covid virus. Robert Palmer tested positive for covid today in the pod, confirming my suspicions
